

Airport Ops & Admin

Efforts are underway to construct a new terminal building at the airport. The initial programming element has been completed which was informed through a stakeholder meeting and various one-on-one discussions with airport tenants. Public Works is currently evaluating alternatives to complete the design and construction of the new terminal building.

Compton/Woodley Airport was established as an airport in 1924 which means that this year is the 100th anniversary of the airport! For a century, the airport has served as a vital hub for aviation, connecting people, businesses, and communities across the region.

To commemorate this historic milestone, we are planning a series of events and activities throughout the year. Rents and Fees Study Update

Los Angeles County Public Works engaged an appraiser to conduct aeronautical and non-aeronautical rent studies for facilities at the five County airports. The aeronautical studies included an analysis of information and data for similar hangars and tiedowns at national, regional, comparable, and competitive airports. The non-aeronautical study included a survey of off-airport self-storage rental properties in the vicinity of the airports.

FAA policies and procedures require that airport sponsors charge a fair market commercial rental rate for non-aeronautical use of airport storage facilities. These rates have not seen an increase since 2019. Public Works intends to request approval from the County Board of Supervisors to increase rental rates for the use of airport facilities for non-aeronautical storage purposes to be consistent with the fair market rents determined through the study. Not all rental rates will see an increase, some will decrease. Public Works is continuing to review the aeronautical rent studies and will make a determination in fall 2024 as to whether any aeronautical rent increases are necessary.

If approved by the Board of Supervisors, the new rental rates for the use of airport facilities for non-aeronautical storage purposes will be effective later this year. Any change in your monthly rent will be reflected in your monthly statement at that time.
