



AB 901 & SB 1383 Implementation and Reporting Dates

AB 901

2016 to 2018 – RDRS Informal rulemaking process

 Today

January 26, 2019– RDRS formal rulemaking process ends

April 1, 2019 – RDRS registration opens (entities)

April 30, 2019 – RDRS registration deadline (entities)

July 1, 2019 – RDRS reporting begins

October 15, 2019 – 2nd quarter (last) DRS report due to CalRecycle and jurisdictions

SB 1383

2017 through 2019 – Informal rulemaking process

January 18, 2019 – Formal rulemaking process begins

2019 – CalRecycle to offer support to jurisdictions

January 1, 2020 – 50% reduction in organic disposal

July 1, 2020 – Measuring progress

January 1, 2022 – Enforcement and penalties begin

January 1, 2024 – Expanded enforcement requirements

January 1, 2025 – 75% reduction in organic disposal

AB 901 and SB 1383 Reporting Compatibility

- RDS (AB 939) – CCR, Title 14, Division 7, Chapter 9, Article 9.2
“Disposal Reporting System”, inoperative on October 15, 2019
- RDRS (AB 901) - CCR, Title 14, Division 7, Chapter 9, Article 9.25
“Recycling Disposal Reporting System”, will replace Article 9.2 (2019)
- SB 1383 – Will further modify Article 9.25 RDRS and add certain requirements for organics reporting by entities (January 1, 2022)

SB 1383 - New RDRS Reporting Requirements Effective January 1, 2022

Reporting Entity	Requirement
Hauler	A hauler providing an organic waste collection service shall identify the source streams for the organic waste collection. The source streams being “source separated organics” or “mixed waste organics”
Transfer/Processor	A facility that receives material from either a “mixed waste organic collection stream” and/or from a “source separated organic waste collection stream” shall report various quarterly data for the incoming /outgoing weights of organic waste received and recovered. The data reporting requirements differ with the source streams mentioned above
Recycler/Composter	A recycling or compost facility or operations shall, if applicable, report the monthly percentage organic waste contained in residuals removed from processing as calculated in the regulations
